<p>Criminal Procedure: KCJIS Records</p> <p>Amends law to allow the KBI to enter into agreements with state agencies and municipalities to share and authenticate electronically stored information to the KCJIS central repository. The definition of "criminal justice information system" would be amended to incorporate such electronically stored information, and a definition for "electronically stored information" would be added.
