


NEW KANSAS DRIVERS LICENSE AND ID CARD BEGINNING AUG 1, 2017

Kansas Drivers Licenses and ID Cards issued on or after July 31, 2017, will have a new look. The images below are samples. The vertical layout will still be used for persons under 21 yoa. The new DL/ID Cards have many security features not demonstrated here to preserve security of those features. We suggest your agencies contact your local Alcohol Beverage Control officer who can provide information and training on those security features.

New DL (Front)



This “Gold Star” designates the holder has provided all documentation required for federal identification purposes of the Real ID Act. If there is no star the words “Not for Federal ID” will appear instead, as seen on the ID card sample. That indicates the required documents have not been supplied to the state by the holder of the DL/ID. These will appear on both the DL and ID Cards. **The absence of the Gold Star does not indicate the person is not a citizen nor does it indicate the person is not in the country legally.**

New DL (Back)




The header “Driver’s License” is in dark blue, and “Identification Card” is in light blue. Other colors are used for Commercial DL, Learner Permits, Concealed Carry ID, etc.

The NAME and DOB are in larger fonts than the current license.

Restrictions and endorsements are designated by code on the front of the license with details on the back. **Remember “J” restriction on the front, with the J25 explanation on the back is the new designator for a person with a cognitive disorder.**

New ID Card



This symbol designates the person has completed the first responder training through emergency management required for this designation.

Since ID Cards do not have restriction codes, a person with a cognitive disorder shown on their ID Card will have this designation.

Remember the cognitive disorder designation is optional and not all persons with a cognitive disorder will choose to have this on their DL/ID.
